Xianji LIU, winner of the 50th Tarrega International Classical Guitar Competition in 2016, is the first China native to win the competition in half a century. In September 2018, he returned to his alma mater, Shanghai Conservatory of Music, as a high-level talent introduction. He is currently an associate professor of classical guitar and a master tutor. Liu Xianji graduated from the High School Attached to Shanghai Conservatory of Music, the Central Conservatory of Music and the Cologne Conservatory of Music in Germany. In 2018, Liu Xianji obtained the highest degree from the Weimar Liszt Conservatory of Music in Germany-doctor of performance. Since 2017, he has released five solo albums with Nassos Records, Sony Records and IBS Classical Records of Spain. His performances have spread all over Spain, Germany, Netherlands, Portugal, France, the United States, China and South Korea. His former bands include the Spanish National Radio Symphony Orchestra, the Spanish Valencia Symphony Orchestra, the Spanish Madrid College Symphony Orchestra, the German Jena Philharmonic Orchestra, the Zhejiang Symphony Orchestra and the Shenzhen Symphony Orchestra.
